 - ✓ Financial resources and transfer of technology
 - ✓ V&A, R&O, Art.6
- Annex I Parties reporting in the NCs under the Kyoto Protocol
 - ✓ Convention elements
 - ✓ Supplementary information (national system, national registry, supplementarity, policies and measures under Article 2, domestic and regional programmes, Article 10 (technology transfer and capacity building) and financial resources

Current reviews of Annex I Parties NC as a basis for MRV

- Review of the Annex I Parties NCs under the Convention:
 - ✓ Review by experts review teams co-ordinated by the secretariat
 - ✓ Facilitative nature of the review process that focuses on technical aspects of reporting, including on transparency, completeness and consistency with reporting guidelines
- Annex I Parties reporting in the NCs under the Kyoto Protocol
 - ✓ Shares many common elements with the Convention review, e.g. expert review teams, completeness, transparency and timeliness
 - ✓ Stronger mandate for a detailed technical assessment of the reported elements in the NCs
 - ✓ **Compliance and eligibility to participate in the mechanisms**
- Role of the SBI and COP/CMP
 - ✓ Considering broader implementation issues based on the information reported in the NC and compilation and synthesis reports
